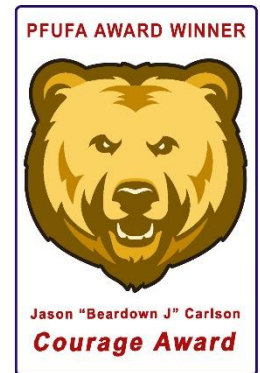


2022 Jason "Beardown J" Carlson Courage Award
