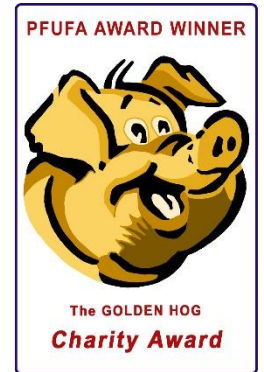


2022 Golden Hog Charity Award
