



2025 AWARD RECIPIENT – Kenny Salinas "THE FAN", Arizona Cardinals

Kenny enthusiastically serves others in his community so that they have nourishing food, while regularly protecting, advocating, educating, and fundraising for numerous charities with his voice and hands. For the past 18 years, Kenny has served twice as President of the Casa Foodbank, he stocks shelves from 4 am - 6 am every single Monday, Wednesday and Friday before going to his "paying" job. On Tuesdays and Thursdays, when he gets off from his job, he takes the day-old pastries from a local grocer to stock shelves at the Foodbank that gets included in their daily food boxes. Kenny is also the Vice President of the Pinal County Junior Livestock Committee. For 11 years, he has supported the efforts of local 4H and Future Farmers of America clubs. For the past 15 years, Kenny has served on the United States Post Office "Stamp Out Hunger" Board where he has volunteered for this national campaign by picking up food on the second Saturdays in May. Kenny is a Board Member of the Pinal County Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASA) (foster care) for the past year. Kenny has been on, around, and for "fostering" organizations actually for 33 years. He and his wife were foster parents for 3 years. Their philosophy is "anything and everything" for foster kids. Kenny is also an active long standing volunteer member of The Salvation Army, where he is now a board member.
